What an incredible year this has been - we are growing up and we are now a REGISTERED CHARITY!!

Breadline beats at the heart of our charity HKFoodWorks and we dedicate our efforts to sustainable food futures. Our vision is to lead the way through research and community action for a better tomorrow.

2023 marks the 3rd year of Breadline's operation - and to date we have welcomed 1500 of you, hit up bakeries 12,176 times and collected over 325,880 pieces of bread. And our volunteer return rate is over 45% - you love us!

Breadline's user-centered research and design are recognised both in HK and abroad. This year we were shortlisted for the HK Design Award and we were invited to present in London at Nesta - a UK innovation agency for social good.

We are passionate about what we do and we partnered up with corporates, schools and universities to bring volunteering to a wider community. We are grateful to have the support of a dedicated team of visually impaired volunteers, and we endeavour to make our runs more inclusive.

We could not have done all of this alone - thank you for running together with us. I look forward to 2024 - and can't wait to celebrate even more milestones with you next year.



Through our collective efforts, we have recovered **325,880 pieces of bread**, as per December 31st, 2023.

We have engaged over 1500 volunteers, and we have visited bakeries 12,176 times to retrieve their bread surplus.







Breadline in 2023





Volunteers

We have given:


